BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BY REGISTERING FOR THE #TEAMMISSION SKYDIVE CHALLENGE YOU ARE AGREEING TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The cost of your jump is £215 you must raise a MINIMUM SPONSORSHIP OF £500 to cover this cost. Your non-refundable booking deposit goes towards the cost of your jump. This sponsorship must be handed in no later than Monday 22 August 2022 - the Monday before your jump. If handed in any later, you run the risk of being unable to complete your jump as the charity will not cover the cost of the jump on Sunday 28 August 2022.
2. Should the weather be unsuitable for jumping on the day, or you have cancelled due to illness or injury with a valid doctor's note, transferring to a new jump date will come at no extra cost.
3. All £50 booking deposits are non-refundable.
4. A £50 re-booking fee will be charged for TRANSFERRING JUMP DATES that have no medical reason associated to it. This is payable to the airfield and is in addition to the original booking deposit. This should not be taken from any sponsorship money raised for Children's Air Ambulance. If the jump date is transferred by the airfield due to bad weather this will come at no extra cost.
5. All cancellations and transfers must be made 4 weeks before the date of the jump. For this jump date any changes will need to be made on or before Friday 29 July 2022.
6. When purchasing any optional extras on the day, this must not be paid out of your minimum sponsorship.
7. Due to current COVID-19 restrictions, only 3 spectators will be allowed per skydiver. All visitors to the drop zone will require a temperature check upon arrival.
8. A face covering must be worn for the whole duration of the skydive. This is from boarding the aircraft to landing on the drop zone.

MEDICAL RESTRICTIONS

You must be at least 16 years old and weigh under 15 stone for men and 13 stone for ladies with your weight in proportion to your height. If you are above the weight, don't worry! You may still be able to jump. Please call the Black Knights Parachute Centre on 01524 791820 to arrange a fitness test. Hire charges apply.

The principal medical restrictions for the tandem skydive are diabetes, epilepsy, fits, recurrent blackouts, heart or lung disease, mental illness and some cases of asthma but if you are in any doubt, please contact the Black Knights Parachute Centre for further information.

You will be required to sign a medical form before your jump declaring your fitness to take part – this will be sent to you on receipt of this registration form but is also available on request.

Those under the age of 18 will need the medical form signed by a parent or guardian. If you think you will need a medical form signed, please get it signed by your doctor before signing up to the #TeamMission Skydive Challenge.

INSURANCE

On payment to the parachute centre of the fee for the training and the jump, all jumpers are covered by the British Parachute Association Liability Insurance Policy up to £2 million for liability to Third Parties. Please note this does not cover you or your dependents for personal injury including death. You are therefore strongly recommended to take out your own insurance cover for personal accidents benefits to whatever level you consider appropriate. You can do this either in conjunction with your own insurance broker or we can provide you with a parachuting Personal Insurance Form. If in any doubt you should seek independent advice.

JUMP SCHEDULE

The #TeamMission Skydive Challenge must be regarded as an "all day" event and your check-in time as advised is no indication of the time that you may jump, which may be delayed or rescheduled. If the activity is not able to take place due to weather or operational issues, your jump will be rescheduled for another date.

If you arrive at the Black Knights Parachute Centre without all necessary documentation, you may forfeit your activity and all monies paid.

If you are unsure about the paperwork required, please contact the Black Knights Parachute Centre on 01524 791820 in advance of your booked date.

COVID-19

As of Monday 14th September 2020, face coverings must be worn while in inside areas, following government guidelines. Face coverings for all visitors is mandatory when social distancing is not possible. Please ensure this is brought with you on the day. The face covering must be worn for the whole duration of the skydive. This is from boarding the aircraft to landing on the drop zone.

If you have been in contact with someone who has COVID-19 or you have been advised to isolate yourself, please contact the Black Knights Parachute Centre on 01524 791820 and they will be happy to reschedule your jump for another date. Please do not visit the parachute centre in person. Alternatively, call Kimberley Wright on 07769 354289 and they will be more than happy to arrange this for you.

IMPORTANT DECLARATION (PLEASE READ)

Parachuting is an adventure sport and participation in such sports necessarily involves a risk of death regardless of the standard of training, supervision and equipment employed. I voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in the sport and I agree for myself and my personal representatives to indemnify and hold harmless the Children's Air Ambulance against any claim or claims whether on my own account or from third parties arising out of any accident or incident resulting in any loss or damage (including bodily injury and death).

I confirm I have read all the above sections marked booking terms and conditions, medical restrictions; insurance and important declaration and I understand and agree to be bound to those terms and conditions and to comply fully with the same.
